In an effort to keep the construction industry, through its construction professionals, abreast of the most efficient methodologies and management tools, Construction Manpower Development Foundation (CMDP) developed the Enhanced Construction Managers' Training and Certification Program (ECOMTCP). The program is centered to support the government's vision to accelerate the provision of safe, efficient, reliable, cost-effective, and sustainable infrastructure projects.

THE BENEFITS OF ENHANCED CONSTRUCTION MANAGERS' TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION PROGRAM

1. Enable to apply internationally-recognized project management standards and best practices to construction projects.
2. Can execute successfully construction projects, from initiation up to closure, while maintaining quality, budget, schedule, and safety requirements .
3. Enable to demonstrate informed decision-making throughout the project life cycle.
4. Can maintain high ethical standards in dealing with construction staff and all stakeholders in the construction process.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Regular training and certification scheme

Target Participants:

1. Potential construction project managers
2. Construction supervisors

Eligibility Requirements:

Private Sector

- Bachelor's Degree in Engineering (Civil/Electrical/ Mechanical/Sanitary/Geodetic/ Materials) or Architecture (excluding Landscape Architecture and Interior Design);
- At least three (3) years of actual experience as a CPM, or 5 years of supervisory experience in actual construction.

Government Sector

- Bachelor's Degree in Engineering or allied fields;
- At least three (2) years of actual experience as a CPM, or 3 years of supervisory experience in actual construction.
- Career Service Executive Eligibility (CSEE).

**No project management education required*

Two-stage Competency Assessment (Competency Exam and Panel Interview):

Candidates are required to take a **50-point competency exam** and a **panel interview** to establish and ensure their capability to demonstrate construction project management competencies. The exam will cover the five core training modules. The panel interview was designed to elicit operational, role-specific, and human-relations questions.

Conferment and Issuance of Certificate:

After sufficiently complying with the eligibility requirements of ECOMTCP, and successfully passing the competency assessment, the candidate shall earn the title of Certified Construction Project Manager This certification merits greater professional recognition of your construction project management achievements; and thereby further establishes your project management competence in the local and international construction industry.

- Construction Project Management (CPM)
- Construction Risk Management (CRM)
- Construction Contract Management (CCM)
- Construction Project Quality Assurance, Quality Control
- Construction Project Cost Estimating, Budgeting and Control
